

## \$450-\$1,800 AG-SEARCH/HAY DAYS SCHOLARSHIP

Ag-Search and Hay Days were two agriculturally important organizations in Logan County. Both organizations were concerned with keeping up with the times to increase the profitability of farming. Providing scholarships for youth interested in agriculture is now the legacy of these two organizations through their donation of funds to the Logan County 4-H Foundation.

**Amount:** The first semester scholarship is \$450. The \$450 scholarship is **renewable** for the second semester if the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 GPA. The \$450 per semester scholarship is **renewable** for a **second year** if the recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA.

### **Eligibility:**

- \* Logan County High School seniors with a 2.5 GPA planning to attend Northeastern Junior College.
- \* Students must pursue a degree in agriculture (agronomy, horticulture, general agriculture, ag business/economics, livestock or ag journalism.)
- \* Graduating seniors must be currently enrolled as a 4-H or FFA member.
- \* The scholarship must be used the fall semester for which it is awarded.

### **Application:**

1. A specific scholarship application form is required.
2. Copy of letter of acceptance from Northeastern Junior College.
3. Two reference letters from the following:
  - a. Teacher
  - b. 4-H leader, FFA instructor or ag business person
  - c. or Reference of your choice
4. Grade transcript (high school and any technical school)
5. Documentation of ACT and/or SAT scores.

**APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY APRIL 1 .** (The scholarship may not be announced yearly if an awardee is eligible for a second year.) Award winner announced by May

1. The scholarship will be paid directly to Northeastern Junior College.
